You work in multiple projects in and outside the office. Taking notes, pictures and voice recordings of presentations, meetings, lectures is part of your daily activity.

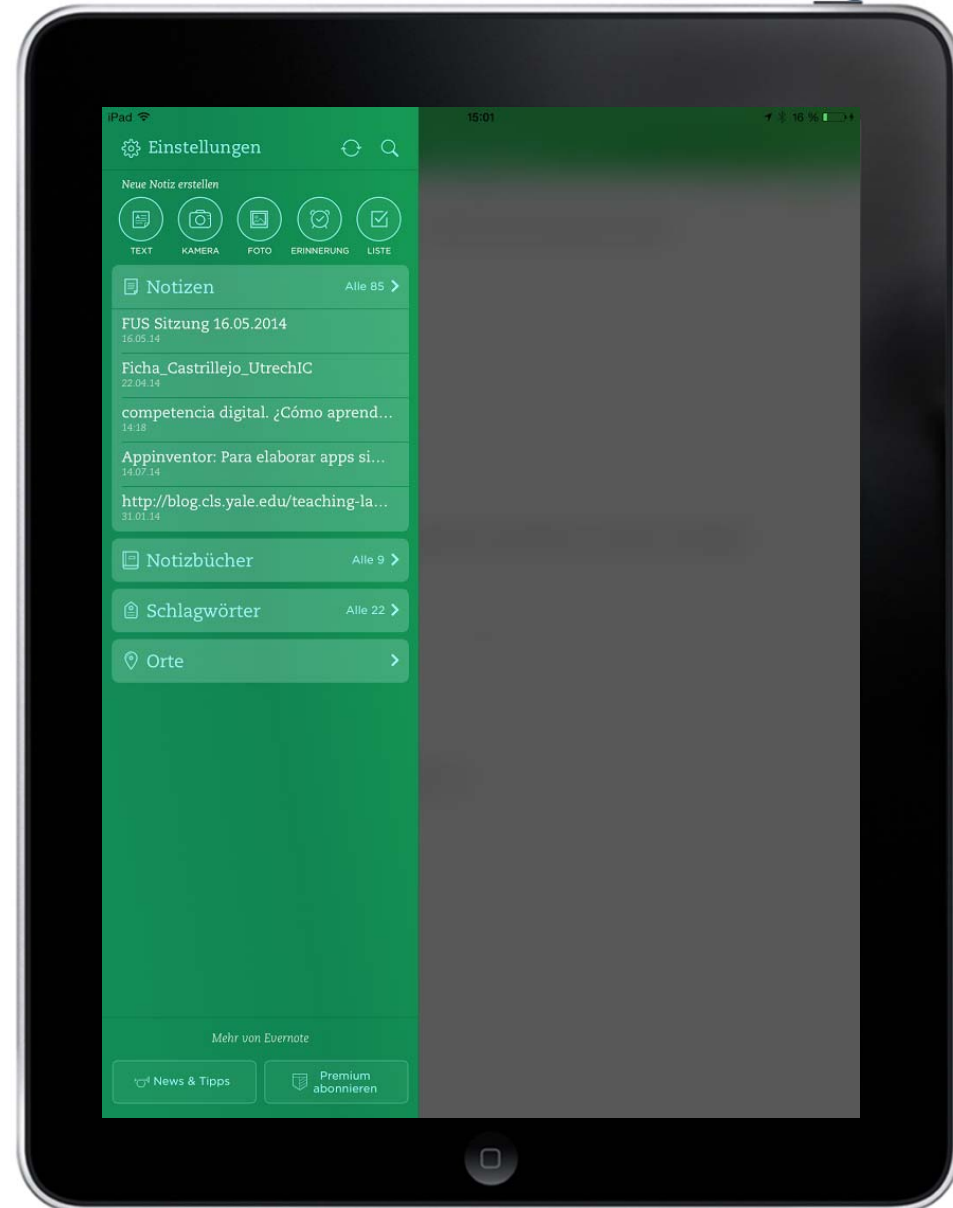
You need a place in the cloud to conveniently store all your notices and notice books and keep track of all your work in progress.

Case 3

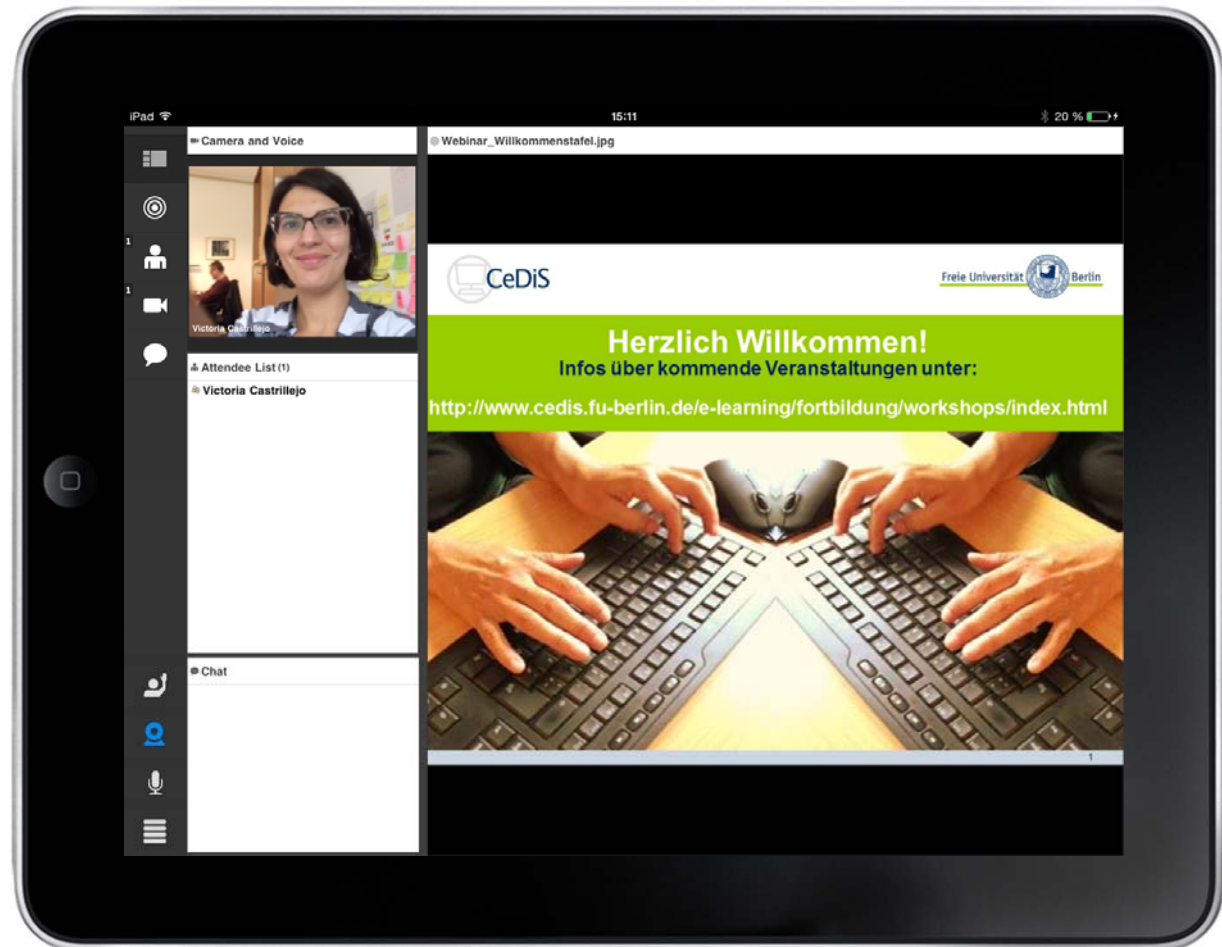


You work with partners outside your office. It would be nice to spare commuting time and schedule meetings online in order to work together or receive training reducing travel and time costs.

Case 4



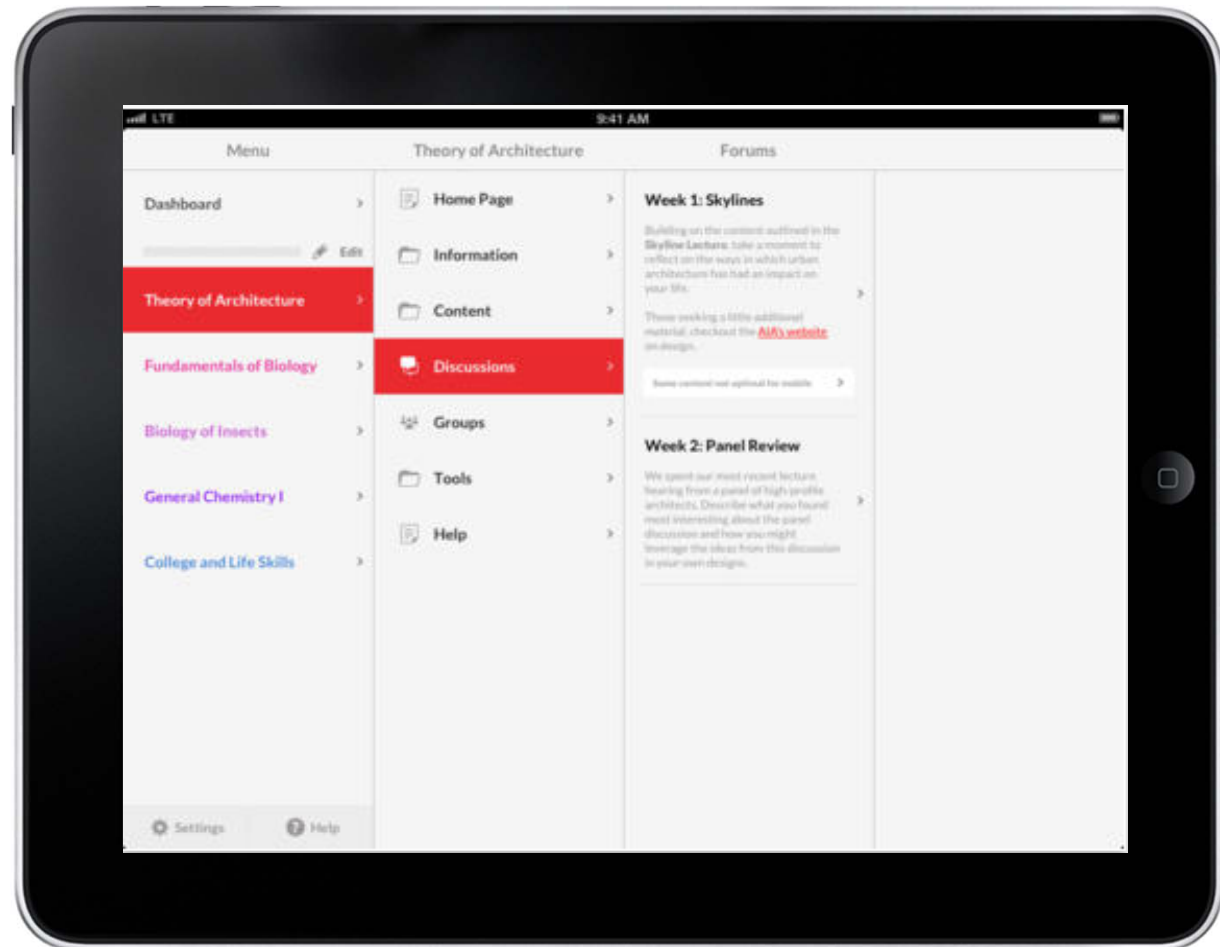
Your educational institution provides Blackboard as Learning Management System. You need to be able to check on your courses from your mobile device.
